

Worksafe Policy Statement

M.J. Patch Structures Ltd promote a Worksafe Policy (Or Refusal to Work Policy) for it's employees and subcontractors while working on their sties and workshops.

Situations arising which lead to a person refusing to work under these terms, must be reported immediately to the management concerned and no work should re-commence until the issued has been satisfactorily resolved.

MJP Structures Ltd additionally provides a confidential reporting arrangement through Staff safety representatives, our Health and Safety Advisors and the HSE. This information is provided through induction briefings, notice boards and in the Company Health and Safety Policy.

Managers, Supervisors, Employees and subcontractors are encouraged to report unsafe acts and near miss events. This policy has been endorsed by Mr. Andrew Raines, Director with full support of the management, and the workforce.
